# ASIA

## CAMBODIA - Sports Coaching, Teaching

Departs: Febuary & March 2012

Live as part of a Khmer community and work on ongoing projects to improve the standard of living for the villagers. Get involved in projects such as supporting an orphanage, construction, teaching and sustainable farming initiatives. On your weekends ride bicycles around local villages, and explore colourful markets and temples.

## INDIA - Teaching English, Community Work

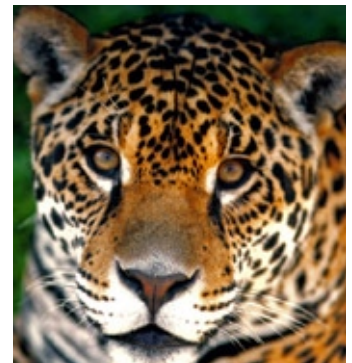
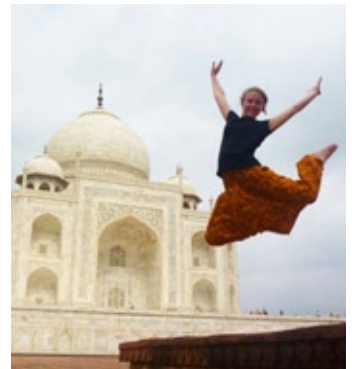
